- maximum of 300 words excluding the title and name(s) and affiliation(s) of author(s)
- MS Word (.doc) or Rich Text Format (.rtf) written in English on A4-sized template with 1" margin on all sides.
- text in 11-point Arial, single-spaced, justified paragraph
- title of the paper in boldfaced capital letters and centered
- name(s) of the author(s) centered with two-line space from the title, presenter's name should be underlined
- author(s)' affiliation centered and one-line space from the name(s), if more than one author, use superscript to indicate affiliation
- indicate if the abstract is for oral, poster or YSF presentation

Email abstracts not later than 15 October 2011 at psbmb2011papers@yahoo.com. Authors of accepted papers will be notified not later than 30 October 2011. Only papers of authors who register by 30 October 2011 will be included in the program and proceedings. Moreover, poster presenters must attend the entire convention in order to be considered for the poster competition.



Payment (cash or check) to PSBMB should be done via the Bank of Philippine Islands (Account No. 3080-0037-48, BPI Loyola-Katipunan Branch, Quezon City). All pre-registrants must submit the completed registration form and a copy of the deposit slip with the name of the participants to the Secretariat on or before 31 October 2011. Students (undergraduates only) should include a copy of their valid ID or other proof of registration. Electronic copies are acceptable for pre-registration, but the original slip should be submitted at the registration desk on the day of the convention.

The University of Santo Tomas, founded in 28 April 1611, is the oldest University in Asia and largest Catholic University in the world. On September 17, 1902, Pope Leo XIII declared the University of Santo Tomas a "Pontifical University", and by 1947, Pope Pius XII bestowed upon it the title of "The Catholic University of the Philippines". For four centuries, it has produced saints and martyrs, national heroes and leaders, and countless professionals who have significantly contributed to the shaping of the history of the Philippines and the development not only of the Filipino society and the Church, but of the region and the international community.

The UST campus is considered a historic site and is a recognizable landmark in Manila and the country. The key role of the University of Santo Tomas in our nation's historical and cultural heritage was recognized by the Philippine National Museum through its formal declaration of the UST Main Building, the Central Seminary, the Arch of the Centuries and the University's Open Spaces as National Cultural Treasures. 
